Course description:

The course covers the fundamental integrative business processes in procurement, production planning, sales, project management, asset management, financial & management accounting and human resources within the SAP ERP application. Participants will be exposed to sufficient knowledge of the core organisation's processes, their integration as well as how they are supported by SAP ERP systems. At the end of the course, participants will sit for a SAP Certification examination and those who will successfully pass will receive the TERP10 SAP Certification.

The typical audience for the TERP10 course includes students as well as professionals in fields such as Application Consultant, Business Analyst, Business Process Owner, Team Lead, Power User, Program/Project Manager as well as those starting the journey to becoming SAP Consultants.

Requirements for course enrolment: You need to be currently registered as a student at a recognized tertiary institution or have graduated within the last 3 months. Unless you have done well in an IS course with integrated SAP Workshops, or have evidence of SAP skills, the ES Fundamentals for Business course is a pre-requisite to the TERP10 course. *Please note: this course is limited to 25 participants, early enrolment is advised.*

The cost of the TERP10 SAP Certification course & examination for professionals is approximately R54 600 (incl. 14% VAT). See details on <https://training.sap.com/za/en>.
